TO ALL THE DULY QUALIFIED, RESIDENT ELECTORS OF GALENA PARK INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an election will be held within and throughout the GALENA PARK INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT (the “District”) on May 4,RCa

In the event the Superintendent, or designee, shall determine from time to time that (a) a polling place hereafter designated shall become unavailable or unsuitable for such use, or it would be in the District's best interests to relocate such polling place, or (b) a presiding judge or alternate presiding judge hereafter designated shall become unqualified or unavailable, the Superintendent, or designee, is hereby authorized to designate and appoint in writing a substitute polling place, presiding judge or alternate presiding judge, and correct or modify the exhibits to this Election Order, giving such notice as is required by the Election Code and as deemed sufficient.

Section 3. Proposition. At the Election there shall be submitted to the resident, qualified electors of the District the following proposition (the "Proposition"):

Section 4. Ballot. The ballot shall conform to the requirements of the Election Code and shall have written or printed thereon the following:

SHALL THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES (THE “BOARD”) OF THE GALENA PARK INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT (THE “DISTRICT”) BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE BONDS OF THE DISTRICT, IN ONE OR MORE SERIES OR INSTALLMENTS, IN AN AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$530,010,000 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, ACQUISITION, RENOVATION AND EQUIPMENT OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS IN THE DISTRICT (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATIONS AND EQUIPMENT FOR, SAFETY AND SECURITY, AND ADDITIONAL GROWTH), ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY AND SITES FOR SCHOOL BUILDINGS, PURCHASE OF SCHOOL BUSE-10 (B)5 (U)-B1-5 (UT0pC(C)-5 H (UE)-1 ()-10[(OF)4 (C1†c 0.3

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ballot indicating “AGAINST” such Proposition. Voting shall be in accordance with the Election Code.

Section 6. Early Voting. The Board hereby appoints Belinda Mendoza as the regular early voting clerk for the District. Early voting, both by personal appearance and by mail, will be conducted in accordance with the Election Code.

Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at the locations, on the dates and at the times as shown in **Exhibit A** which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as a part hereof for all purposes. Early voting by personal appearance shall begin on Monday, April 22, 2024 and end on Tuesday, April 30, 2024.

For the use of those voters who are entitled by law to vote early by mail, the early voting clerk shall provide each voter with a ballot with instructions to mark the ballot indicating his or her vote “FOR” or “AGAINST” the Proposition. Section 7. Conduct of Election. The Election shall be conducted by election officers, including the presiding judges and alternate judges or clerks appointed by the Board, in accordance with the Education Code, the Election Code and the Constitution and laws of the State and the

Superintendent, or designee, using the standardized training program and materials developed and provided by the Secretary of State.

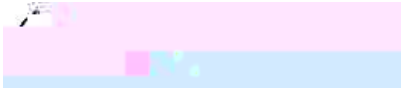
